Do you know that 20% of American teenagers have a moderate to severe hearing loss, mostly due to earbuds and loud music?

There are many more statistics, but the reality is that we can and should do something about this within the walls of our churches. This is an opportunity to both maintain the size of our current congregations, but also to grow them as we in the NIC take a leadership position to open our doors to those with hearing loss.

One of the easiest and most economical solutions is by installing a “hearing loop” system. It is simple to install during a remodeling, as a separate project or as part of new construction. You can do part of the building, or all of the major rooms. The result will be a wonderful sound for those that need it and it can also be a tool to use when seeking new members.
