What: Join a United Methodist Teen Learning Group, which will meet monthly on a Sunday afternoon (hybrid style with on-line meetings and in-person when that is permitted).

Who: Rising freshman to rising seniors who are committed to learning about and doing this work from August 2021 – May 2022. Following the year's program, students are invited to be leaders and facilitators.

How: Teens will gather along with young adult/adult coaches and mentors to experience a variety of talks, discussions, films, music and learning opportunities around fighting racism.

Cost: \$50 per student for the program year, August 2021 – May 2022.
