2021 Easter Greeting - Bishop John L. Hopkins

Christ is Risen! Christ is Risen Indeed. Alleluia!

One of my favorite Easter Hymns is *Thine be the Glory*. In three verses, the Resurrection our Lord Jesus Christ is proclaimed with all its power and joy.

The first verse describes what happened at the tomb:

Thine be the glory, risen, conquering Son;

Endless is the victory, Thou o'er death hast won;

Angels in bright raiment rolled the stone away,

And the third verse calls us to a life of faith.

Bring us safe through Jordan to Thy home above.

Thine be the glory, risen, conquering Son;

Endless is the victory, Thou o'er death hast won;

The sure victory over sin and death enables us to live forgiven and free. Not intimidated by fears within us or threats beyond us, we can follow Jesus and serve others because He lives!

The Apostle Paul captured it in Romans 8, "It is Christ Jesus, who died, *yes*, who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who indeed intercedes for us.

Who will separate us from the love of Christ? Will hardship, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril or sword?

nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord."
