Faith and the Prison Pipeline: Understanding and Interpreting the School-to-Prison Pipeline

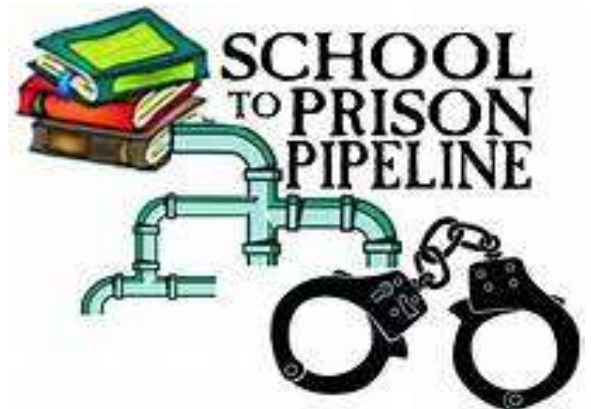
The school-to-prison pipeline is a term describing how children and youth are rerouted by systems and institutions and funneled away from educational success towards the criminal justice system.
