

Recap on the 3 R's



Regionalization creates equity across the Church without privileging one region as the center and others as peripheries.

REMOVAL of HARMFUL language

Recap on the 3 R's

- Funding ban for LGBTQIA+ ministries removed
- Restrictions on Ordination of queer clergy persons removed
- Removal of mandatory minimum penalties for clergy holding same-sex weddings
 - Traditional plan repealed
 - Reinstatement process created





Social Principles REVISED

Recap on the 3 R's

- not church law
- •intended to inform United Methodists on matters of the day with a biblical foundation.
- •First overhaul of Social Principles in nearly 50 years.

 Paragraph 2553 that was created as a special process for disaffiliation is GONE!





What MORE??





HARMFUL Language REMOVED from Discipline

- Funding ban for LGBTQ+ ministries removed
- Ordination Restrictions removed
- Removed penalties for officiating same-gender weddings





HARMFUL Language REMOVED from Discipline

- Removed ban on same gender weddings from UMC church buildings
- Removed mandatory minimum penalties established by the 2019 Traditional Plan
- Incapability Clause removed from Discipline





Patheway to RETURN for CLERGY

•Pathway created for clergy stripped of license or orders due to being LGBTQ+ or celebrating same gender marriages created.



Patheway to RETURN for CLERGY

- Persons have one year to request licenses or orders to be restored.
- •If an annual conference does not restore the license or orders, requesting another Annual conference is possible.

New Pension Plan

- Clergy serving multiple years will be enrolled in multiple pension plans, based upon the year they worked.
- Only service years of 2026 and after will earn benefits through the Compass framework.

RACIAL JUSTICE

• 5th focus added to OUR MISSIONAL STRATEGIES to eliminate racism, racial inequity, colonialism, white privilege, and white supremacy within the Church and our society.



- Disability Ministries Committen Man Justice reinstated and placed under GCORR.
- call to educate about the root causes and manifestations of racism, ethnocentrism, and tribalism and develop strategies for overcoming these kinds of social divisions.



Constitutional Amendments

Constitutional amendments all passed 2020/24 General Conference by at least 2/3 of total voting members





Constitutional Amendments

 Racial Justice (¶5)
 Include 'gender' and 'ability' (¶4)
 Edit of the educational requirements for voting privileges to elect clergy delegates to General Conference (¶35)
Worldwide Regionalization





Voting members in annual conferences across the globe will vote on amendment adoption NIC at 2025 Annual Conference



A constitutional amendment will pass if 2/3 of total voting members of all of the annual conferences combined support the amendment





Why is it named "regional conference" rather than a "central conference"





General Conference Debriefing



Fully maintained:

- The Council of Bishops
- Judicial Council
- General Agencies
- General Conference
- Jurisdictional Conferences







A regional conference CAN:

- Draft and publish their own regional Book of Discipline, hymnals, books of worship and other liturgical resources
- Set requirements for ordination and licensed ministry with respect to their needs and resources
- Set standards for lay membership



A regional conference CAN:

- Develop practices around marriage ceremonies, funerals and other rites that align with cultural contexts and laws in each country
- Reorganize their annual conferences, districts or charge conferences to best serve their missional needs and convene their own judicial courts
- Work with annual conferences to ensure policies and practices align with the laws in each country


