Certified Lay Servants

Requirements for Certified Lay Servant:

- Apply in writing to the Lay Servant Ministry Academy Committee and be recommended by the Pastor and the Administrative Council or Church Conference of the local church where he/she holds membership
- 2. Complete the Basic Course.
- 3. Complete the Advanced Course(s). See the 2016 UM Book of Discipline, ¶668.

Re-certification of Lay Servants Requirements for re-certification of Lay Servants.

- 1. Endorsement of the Pastor and Administrative Council or Church Conference.
- 2. Written request for recertification.
- 3. Completion of one Advanced course every three years.

2020 Spring Academy Course Offerings

1. Introduction to Lay Speaking: Basic Course (Book cost \$11.00) Mr. Thom Bell, Certified Lay Servant, and member of Faith UMC, Dolton IL, is the instructor for this course. The Basic Course is the foundation for all courses in Lay Servant Ministries. Students will learn the importance of exercising servant leadership and developing future leaders.

- 2. United Methodist Heritage Living Our Faith: The United Methodist Way (Book cost: \$13.00) *Ms. Lara Batchelor*, Certified Lay Servant, and member of First UMC of Evergreen Park is the instructor for this course. This course will explore the special gifts of theology, witness, and organization that The United Methodist Church brings to the church universal, how we got where we are today and how our distinctive emphases are still needed in the 21st century church.
- **3.** Worshiping with United Methodists (Book cost \$12.00) *Ms. Geraldine Jordan*, Certified Lay Servant, and member of St. Mark UMC, Chicago, IL is the instructor for this course. This course focuses on the ministry of the Lay Servant who either regularly or occasionally leads a group or congregation in workshop.
- **4. Biblical Interpretation: A Roadmap** (Book cost \$19.50) *Rev. Larry Paris*, Pastor of First UMC of Evergreen Park is the instructor for this course. This course opens a new world for many Lay Servants who have not had professional training in biblical interpretation.
- **5. Polity, Practice, and the Mission of The United Methodist Church** (Book cost \$19.00). *Rev. Dr Jacques A. Conway,* Chicago Southern District Superintendent, is the instructor for this course. This course gives participants an overview of the structure and organization of The United Methodist Church.

- Persons seeking to become Certified Lay Servants must take prescribed courses.

ALL Lay Servants are REQUIRED to submit annual reports to their Charge Conference.
