BASIC COURSES

Lay Servant Basic Course +*

(Led by Peggy Hansen)

Participants are invited to consider the importance of exercising servant leadership, developing future leaders, remaining rooted in consistent spiritual practices, and being part of a group that holds members accountable in discipleship.

ADVANCED COURSES

Living as a United Methodist (UM Heritage) +*

(Led by Pastor Brenda Morris)

This advanced course is required to become a certified lay servant. Participants gain an understanding of the distinctive traditions and emphases of the United Methodist Church.

Justice in Everyday Life

(Led by Pastor Violet Johnicker)

This advanced course, takes an in-depth look at the Social Principles of The United Methodist Church — the church's attempt to speak on contemporary issues with which it is confronted today. The book covers topics such as the following: Natural World, Social Community, Economic Community, Political Community, Biblical Foundations of the Social Principles, and Teaching the Social Principles. It is not only for Lay Servants but is for anyone interested in studying the Social Principles in greater detail.

Discovering Your Spiritual Gifts +

(Led By Chaplain Chris Druce-Jones)

This course helps participants understand spiritual gifts and how the church can use them to fulfill its mission and ministry. Participants will also learn what it means to be a spiritual leader and will be equipped to lead others in exploring and using their spiritual gifts.

You Can Preach *

(Led by Pastor Gary Rich)

Laypersons who are called to preach on occasion, but who are not formally trained as preachers, will find this simple, direct booklet to be both practical and accessible. Designed for lay speakers, lay leaders, pastors and student pastors who have not completed formal preaching training, pastors seeking a basic refresher course, others who are called upon to preach in their pastor's absence.
