Values

Vision

Vocation

Values

We got these from our parents, grandparents, teachers, religious leaders and other influencers in our lives.

Vision

This is what you hope the world would become because you lived on this earth.

Vocation

This is the job you've been called to do.

It may be different from the job you have to do.

The 3Vs Make Up Your...



Self-Interest...

Is the force that arises from the bottom of your heart (or gut) that compels you to become the kind of person who has the ability fulfil your vision or calling.

Self-Interest

Is not the same as your vision

Ask: What kind of person do I have to become

in order to accomplish my vision.

Self-Interest...

is NOT Selfishness (which denies others)

It is NOT Selflessness (which denies yourself)

Self-Interest (affirms God's calling).

One-On-Ones

One on Ones are not



- A chit-chat
- A questionnaire
- A discussion on issues,
- A discussion on tasks or projects



One-on-Ones



They have one clear goal:

Discover Shared Self-Interest



One-On-Ones

Do one-on-ones with those whom you find are:



Interesting Curious Likeable Energizing Trustworthy

And those who you think with like you and will build trust with you.



How to do a one-on-one

Make an appointment



It is usually about 30 minutes long

Listen deeply

Ask questions with Curiosity and Courage

Come away ENERGIZED!

Immediately after the appointment, write notes.



One-on-Ones must become a Discipline

- You need an accountability partner
- You need to make a commitment that you will do at least

two one-on-ones a week



Do lots of one on ones



- With neighbors
- Those who are different, in religion, race, gender, sexual orientation etc.
- Those who live outside the US, particularly in the Global South
