- 1. be recommended by the pastor and church council or charge conference of the United Methodist church in which you hold membership.
- 2. Complete the "Introduction to Lay Ministries: The BASIC Course."
- 3. Complete an advanced lay servant ministries course.
- 4. Apply to and have qualifications reviewed by the district committee on lay servant ministries or equivalent structure (See ¶668.3).

To become a Certified Lay Speaker, you must:

- 1. Be certified as a lay servant (or equivalent as defined by your central conference)
- 2. Obtain recommendation from the pastor and the church council or charge conference of the local church in which you hold membership.
- 3. Complete a track of study including courses on leading worship, leading prayer, discovering spiritual gifts, preaching, United Methodist heritage and polity, and/ or other courses as determined by the conference committee on lay servant ministries or equivalent structure.
- 4. Interview with and obtain recommendation from the district committee on lay servant ministries, or equivalent structure, to be submitted to the conference committee on lay servant ministries, or equivalent structure, for approval and certification.

# Introduction to Lay Servant Ministry: The BASIC Course

The foundational course for all lay servant ministries will encourage students to discover and use spiritual gifts as God intended and to consider the importance of exercising servant leadership, developing future leaders, remaining rooted in consistent spiritual practices, and being in a group that holds members accountable in discipleship.
