

## Northern Illinois Conference Program Ministry Grants Frequently Asked Questions

- Q: Who can apply for a Program Ministry grant?
- A: Any entity that is part of a local congregation can apply for a grant. The pastor and Church Council (or equivalent) must endorse the request.
- Q: Who decides what grants are awarded for Social Reform, Redevelopment and Creative Ministries?
- A: The sponsoring committee will review applications and make awards.
- Q: What funding amounts are available to the local church through Program Ministry Grants?
- A: Grants typically range from \$1,500 3,000.
- Q: What follow up is required of those awarded a Program Ministry grant?
- A: One year after the grant is awarded, or sooner if your project timeline is less than a year, recipients are asked to submit a project evaluation.
- Q: How will funds be distributed?
- A: Checks are mailed to the local church treasurer for use in the project.
- Q: Can I use grant money to fund staff position?
- A: No. Grants may only be used to fund projects and programs, not staff.
- Q: What are the grants offered through Northern Illinois Conference and related entities?
