

Program Ministry Grants Information and Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Who can apply for a program ministry grant?

- A: Any entity that is part of an NIC congregation can apply for a grant. The pastor and church council (or equivalent) must endorse the request.
- Q: Who decides what grants are awarded for social reform, redevelopment, and creative ministries grants?
- A: The sponsoring committee will review applications and make awards.
- Q: What funding amounts are available to NIC congregations through program ministry grants?
- A: Grant amounts typically range from \$1,500 to \$3,000, depending on the category.

Q: What follow-up is required of those awarded a program ministry grant?

A: One year after the grant is awarded, or sooner if the timeline is less than a year, recipients will be asked to complete an evaluation form. Churches that receive grants will also get information on where to send the evaluation, etc.

Q: How will funds be distributed?

A: Checks will be mailed to the church treasurer, designated for the project.

Q: Can I use grant money to fund a staff position?

A: No. Grants may only be used to fund projects and programs, not staff.
