The duties of the Executive Director include the day-to-day management of the ministry including the supervision of staff and fiduciary responsibility, the oversight of the maintenance and care of the facility, fundraising and marketing, and works in collaboration with the Board of Directors to guide the ministry and strategically plan for the future.
