### **Conference and District Advance Specials Criteria**

Not all applications will be included in the Rainbow Covenant booklet. Submission of application does not guarantee approval. The Board of Global Ministries approves a preliminary list of Advances which are then submitted to the Annual Conference for approval. To be approved by the Board of Global Ministries as a Conference or District Advance Special, a ministry/project/agency must meet the following criteria...

- 1. Have a mission statement reflective of the mission statement of the Northern Illinois Conference. See umcnic.org.
- 2. Be affiliated with the United Methodist Church by mandate of the organization.

#### For example:

- a. Inclusion of board members who are United Methodists.
- b. Partner with churches within the United Methodist connection.
- c. Be housed within a United Methodist church.
- d. Do ministry reflective of The Social Principles or Mission Goals of The UMC.
- e. Receive financial support from local United Methodist churches.
- 3. Provide ministry within the boundaries of the Northern Illinois Conference.
- 4. Provide a ministry that engages multiple United Methodist churches and their people beyond the local area.
- 5. Be a legal, non-profit organization or under the umbrella of a legal, nonprofit entity.
- 6. Provide evidence of a yearly financial review. Proof of audit and/or financial reports are welcome.

# **Special Notes:**

If a church has its own individual ministry that is primarily a mission of just that local church, like a food pantry or after-school program, it may not need an Advance number. Anyone can contribute to that ministry by giving to that local church. Only when a ministry is a larger effort of many congregations or an independent non-profit would it need an Advance.

By receiving an Advance number, a ministry is essentially establishing a tool for UMC congregations to give funds. Being an Advance does not guarantee receipt of any funds.

Advances receiving funds below a threshold amount will be asked to seek support through means other than the Advance. Ministry must maintain relationships with the Board of Global Ministries each year by submitting newsletters, stories, direct e-mails, or other engagement.

Ministries may use only one Advance number to support their projects.
