REAFFIRMATION OF THE BAPTISMAL COVENANT

The New Testament records that Jesus was baptized by John, and he commanded his disciples to teach and baptize in the name of the Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit (Matt. 28:19). Baptism is grounded in the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, and involves dying to sin, newness of life, union with Christ, receiving the Holy Spirit, and incorporation into Christ's church.
