Rockford Urban Ministries Update: Interfaith Thanksgiving, CROP Walk and new Grant

- The Rockford Interfaith Council 33d Annual Interfaith Thanksgiving Service will also be online.
- Violet Johnicker has secured a grant for a part time organizer to focus on building public support for the Pretrial Fairness Act as part of the Illinois Legislative Black Caucus' criminal justice reform bill that passed in January of this year, eliminating the unjust practice of money bond - incarcerating people before they have been convicted of a crime just because they don't have the cash to pay bond. Beginning in 2023 pretrial incarceration will be based solely on whether a person poses a specific threat, and wealth plays no role in who is incarcerated and who is free.
