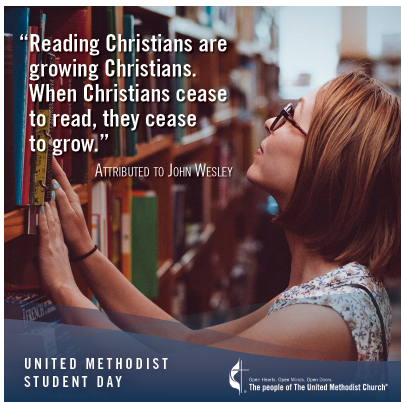

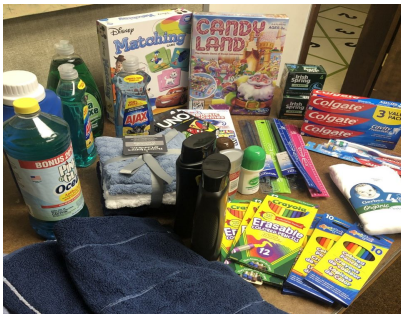


Special Sunday: United Methodist Student Day

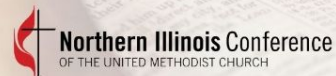
