# WILLOW UMC HOLDS 54th VERSION OF THE WILLOW FOLK FESTIVAL



The Willow United Methodist

Church, located in Jo Daviess County, eight miles southeast of Stockton, held the 54th version of the Willow Folk Festival on August 14-15, 2021. The Folk Festival started as a one-day fundraiser and revival in 1968 and has expanded to offer camping and music in a one-of-a-kind environment. Over the years, it has turned into an iconic event in the area.

People and families from generation to generation come to Willow from all over the country for a weekend in August to sing and enjoy bluegrass music. "We hope as a church to plant seeds to spread the word of Jesus Christ to all these people," said Karl Lawfer, Lay Leader of Willow UMC.

The worship time on Sunday is reserved for Willow UMC to offer a one-hour presentation with prayers and well-known hymns as "Leaning on the everlasting arms," "How Great Thou Art," "Down by the Riverside," among other medleys.



The church prepares the area for

campers, sells food, sets up the stage, sound equipment, and allows people to sing with guitars, banjos, autoharps, or any other folk instrument for a 15minute segment over the weekend. "This is an attempt to be a witness to all those who come and sing. The church prays over the campground, the church lawn as people sit, gather, and eat," said Pastor Cheryl Carroll.

In 2020 the church offered a Virtual Festival with singers from all over, and this year, 2021, they decided to have it in person as it is held outside with safety guidelines for those who enter the church building.

"Willow is family, friends, music, and love," says the official slogan of the event, which continues to thrive because of the hard work of the church members and the support of the friends and families that gather to share music and fellowship during this annual weekend.
