



CLERGY ETHICS TRAININGS

This training is mandatory for all clergy under appointment in the Northern Illinois Conference and is valid for 4 years. It's a two-hour, online course. It covers critical boundary awareness, abuse prevention, and ethical guidelines for faith leaders and volunteers working with vulnerable groups.

To complete the Clergy Ethics training you will need to start at the Safe Gatherings website: www.safegatherings.com

- 1) Click on the green **CLERGY ETHICS COURSE** button in the upper right hand side of the Safe Gatherings home page.
- 2) On this next page you will have fields that need to be completed in order:
 - a) Language Preference: The default is **ENGLISH**
 - b) Select Denomination: Select **METHODIST**
 - c) Select the country for your organization: The default is **UNITED STATES**
 - d) Select the state/province for your organization: Select **ILLINOIS**
 - e) Type the most **UNIQUE** part of your organization name, then select: Please type **CLERGY**, then select **Clergy-Northern IL**

Note: The city in which the organization is located will auto fill with "Chicago"

You will then continue to complete the remaining fields with your information and create your login. The username will autofill with your email address that you provide, or you can create a different username.
